



The School Coronavirus Plan was developed around three primary areas:

PREVENTION

- Develop and monitor protocols for virus prevention.
- Talk to pupils about the disease explaining the symptoms but also reassuring them.
- Tell them what they can do to be COVID-19 fighters.
- Institute handwashing breaks throughout the school day, specifically at the start and end of the day, before break and at lunch times.
- Teach 20 second handwashing time through demonstration.
- Teach pupils to cover coughs/sneezes, avoid touching face. Avoid personal contact such as handshaking, fist bumping, hugging.
- Increase disinfection of all surfaces, especially high contact areas such as door handles, desk tops, and other high traffic areas.
- Provide hand sanitizers and cleaning wipes to groups going on school visits, reminding children and staff to avoid contact with members of the public where possible, wash hands regularly whilst out and sanitize / wipe hands when getting on and off the coach.
- Increase monitoring of pupils through school staff to look for symptoms on a continuing basis. If a child has symptoms of a new and persistent cough, fever or shortness of breath, parents will be contacted and asked to collect the child from school.
- Encourage children with long hair to tie their hair back – hair is a frequent source of droplet-based transmission.
- Clean shared equipment such as iPads and Chromebook before and after use.
- Ensure all children have their own water bottles as no shared cups will be available
- Staff or pupils who have travelled out of the country must self-monitor for a minimum of 7 days.
- Staff or pupils who have travelled from a high-risk area, as determined by Public Health England must self-monitor at home for minimum of 7 days and be symptom free before returning to school.
- Staff or pupils who are living with or have been in direct contact with someone who has Contracted COVID-19 must self-monitor at home for a minimum of 7 days and be symptom free before returning to school.

MITIGATE/DELAY

- Provide CPS Coronavirus Synopsis of Action Plan to all school staff and publish synopsis of this on school website
- Consider reducing contact situations:
 - Assemblies
 - Carpet time
 - School events
 - Trips



- Consider:
 - Any screening measures e.g. use of a thermometer in school.
 - Increase time of exclusion from school for those with symptoms (beyond 48hrs)
 - Sending home any children with any symptoms
 - Additional Cleaning including deeper cleans
- Update website on a regular basis with the latest information regarding System Coronavirus (COVID-19) and other important school information.
- Establish lines of communication with other local schools, agencies and the LEA.

CONTAINMENT

- Full closures of site / classes
- Deep cleans
- Closure of lettings and building use
- Reduction or exclusion of visitors
